

GENERAL GUIDELINES for POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR:

1. Pupils are expected to treat all adults and fellow pupils with respect and courtesy at all times.
2. Pupils are expected to show respect for all school property and to keep the school environment clean and litter free.
3. Pupils are expected to take pride in their appearance, to have all books and required materials and to be in the right place at the right time.
4. Pupils are expected to obey a teacher's instructions, to work to the best of their ability and to present assignments neatly.
5. Pupils are expected to attend school every day unless there is a genuine reason for absence, in which case the class teacher must be informed in writing, stating the reason for absence.
