Principals Report:

- Current pupil numbers 347

- Staff Update – Ms Keyes and Ms Hurley will be retiring at the end of the school year. The position of deputy principal is hoped to be filled by the end of May. Ms Hegarty will also leave the school at the end of this year. Due to these staff changes there is likely to be a delay in issuing teacher lists for the coming school year.
