Over 300 tickets have been sold for The "Spring Time Draw". Thank you to all the families and to the wider community who have supported us again this year.

## **Principles Report:**

School Build: the Department of Education have agreed to provide us with Emergency funding of €75,000 for the repair to the roof in the senior building. They have cancelled our Summer Works Grant which we were going to use to update the heating system in the junior school. Tendering is now underway and we hope to have to roof replaced/repaired over the summer months.

A letter will be drawn up from the BOM to request that the council build a pathway right around from the back of the school.

September Term: There will be two Junior Infant Classes and two senior Infants classes this following September. 48 places have been accepted by new children. We will have 303 students on our role but another 4 children are needed to guarantee us 12 teachers.

Mr Keddy 3rd & Ms Gillick's 4th classes will take part in a study in relation to homework. Throughout the month of April both cases will have no homework to do at home, it will be carried out in class every morning to see if there is a need for children to continue to carry out homework at home.

St. Patrick's Day Parade: The children are asked to meet at Killadreenan Close at 11 to walk in the Parade. Parents of the smaller children are asked to walk with them for safety reasons. There will be a party in the Druid's Well car park afterwards.

Congratulations to Mr. Keddy & 3<sup>rd</sup> class for his production of Tir Na Og. There was a great turn out by all the parents and the play received an excellent write up in the "Wicklow Times". Well done to everyone involved.

Thank you to the 3 families that have come forward and have offered to facilitate a programme where students will come from Spain and attend our school. The students will integrate with 5th class students.

Congratulations to the Students who took part in The Irish Board of Speech & Drama Exams. Thank you to Ms Keenan for all of her help in preparation. Subsequently 3 students will be presented with Gold Medals this year. The students were from  $2^{nd}$ ,  $4^{th}$  &  $6^{th}$  Class.

School Tours are now being booked, monies can be paid into office, and also book money can also be paid off for next year.

Communion: Two ceremonies will be held on the 14<sup>th</sup> May, due to the number of children in each class. These ceremonies will see 52 children receiving First Holy Communion. Just a reminder to the parents of 3<sup>rd</sup> class, that they will be required to provide refreshments and facilitate tea and coffee for these services.
