Currently there are some interesting articles and surveys regarding After School Care & an outbreak of Measles. Further to this we would ask all parents to ensure their children are up to date with all vaccinations and to not send your child to school with a rash until checked by your GP, as we have a number of children in our school with compromised immune systems.

Senior school: The roof was repaired during the holidays & the old Perspex ceiling has been replaced it is hoped that this will remedy the ongoing leak.

Car park & road safety: We would ask parents who have children going to the senior school to speak with them & ensure they are road safety aware as staff cars are turning into the carparks there.
